MONEY MATTERS

FINANCING A DEGREE IS A TEAM EFFORT AND HERE'S HOW MOUNT ALLISON CAN HELP STUDENTS GET HERE:

- **Scholarships:** awarded based on academic achievement, as well as extracurricular involvement, leadership experience, community service, and work/internship experience (value \$4,000 to \$70,000)
- **Bursaries:** awarded based on demonstrated financial need at the time of application; students apply for bursaries in a separate application once they have been admitted to Mount Allison
- **Student employment:** more than 700 students have on-campus work opportunities during the academic year and throughout the summer months

LIVING IN SACKVILLE

In a small town, there are big opportunities for students to immerse themselves in the community. The downtown is just a five-minute walk from campus, you can drive to all major Maritime cities in two hours or less, and an international airport is less than a 30-minute drive away.



TRANSCRIPTS
