Conditional admissions process	We can assess for conditional offers as early as November based on first semester's midterm grades and grade 11 grades. Any grade 11 grade will be replaced by the completion of grade 12 credits.
IB credit information	Applicants who have successfully completed the IB diploma with at least six subjects, including three at the higher level (HL), with a minimum final score of 24 (not including bonus points), will be considered for admission. Program specific prerequisites may apply.
