Minimum Alberta admission requirements	Diploma: 60% in Mathematics (Grade 11 or 12) C, M or U as well as Grade 12 English (C or U) Degree: Minimum of 65% overall average. Six Grade 12 U or M courses. Grade 12 English and Grade 12 mathematics at U level.

Minimum admission average	BBAA/AUBU: minimum 65% overall average.
Conditional admissions process	Offers may be conditional on completion of outstanding admission requirements and receipt of final grades/transcripts.
IB credit information	IB courses are accepted for admission where they meet the required prerequisite equivalencies. High-school IB courses do not normally receive Georgian transfer credit. Official transcripts are required.
AP credit information	AP courses are accepted for admission where they meet the required prerequisite equivalencies. Official transcripts are required. AP high-school courses do not automatically receive Georgian College transfer credit; exemptions are assessed on an individual basis.
Policy on repeated courses	Repeated courses are accepted. Georgian does not state that repeating a prerequisite automatically disqualifies an applicant. The applicant must still meet the program's admission requirements.
Policy on summer school, night school, online courses, and correspondence courses	These are generally accepted when the course is recognized as equivalent to the required Ontario secondary-school prerequisite. Georgian recognizes courses completed through different delivery methods, including online learning.
Treatment of out-of-province high school courses from schools such as Blyth or MEI	Out-of-province high school courses are assessed for equivalency. Applicants must provide an official transcript, and Georgian evaluates courses completed outside Ontario against the educational standards of the province in which they were completed. Course

	descriptions may be requested if required for evaluation.
Application deadline	Apply through the Ontario Colleges Application Service (OCAS); deadlines vary by program/intake and availability.
Application fee	OCAS application fee applies. \$160
Timing of offers/grades used	Offers are based on available academic information and are subject to final grades/transcripts.

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ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Treatment of diploma marks	For applicants entering a degree pathway from a diploma, transfer/admission credit is assessed by Georgian College. Direct BBAA applicants are assessed on their secondary-school qualifications.
Transcript requirements	Official secondary-school transcript/records are required for admission assessment; out-of-province applicants should provide official records as requested by Georgian College.
Tuition differentials	Tuition and ancillary fees vary by program and academic year. Current fees should be confirmed through Georgian College's fee schedule.
Treatment of second choice program(s)	Applicants may select a second-choice program on their application. If they are not eligible for or are not offered admission to their first-choice program, their application may be considered for their second-choice program, provided they meet that program's admission requirements and space is available.
