

# Final Admission Requirements

## FINALIZE YOUR CONDITIONAL ADMISSION FOR FALL 2023

**Step One:** Check your admission letter to confirm which faculty of study you have been admitted to and then find your faculty in the chart below. You will need to **complete all of the corresponding high school courses** with the minimum overall average required.

**Step Two:** Submit your Final Official Transcript from your province's official online portal, after graduation, by August 1, 2023. This transcript must indicate your graduation date.

**Final official high school transcripts must be received by Enrolment Services by August 1, 2023.**

Faxes, photocopies, and emailed transcripts from the student are NOT accepted.

## FINAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS BY FACULTY

FACULTY AVERAGE REQUIRED	COURSES USED TO CALCULATE FINAL AVERAGE
<b>Arts - 70%</b> 60-69.99% will be admitted to Arts Qualifying Year. Economics major requires Math 30-1 or Math 30-2 with a minimum grade of 70%. <b>Education - 65%</b> All programs are competitive entry. Elementary Education program requires one 30-level Math Course (excluding Math 31). Secondary Education major or minor in Math or Physics requires Math 30-1. Secondary Education major or minor in Chemistry requires Math 30-1, Chemistry 30, and Physics 30. Joint BMus/BMusEd program requires an interview, music theory test, and audition. <b>Kinesiology &amp; Health Studies (Health Studies ONLY) - 70%</b> <b>La Cité universitaire francophone - 65%</b> <b>Media, Art, &amp; Performance - 65%</b> BFA & CFA programs in Visual Arts or Indigenous Art require a portfolio. BMus program requires an interview, music theory test, and audition. <b>Social Work (U of R Pre-SW/FNUniv Indigenous SW Qualifying) - 70%</b>	English Language Arts 30-1 One Course from Category A or B One Course from Category A or B One Course from Category A or B One Course from Category A, B, or C
<b>Business Administration - 70%</b>	English Language Arts 30-1 Math 30-1 or Math 30-2 One Course from Category A or B One Course from Category A or B One Course from Category A or B
<b>Engineering &amp; Applied Science - 90% (Major of Choice) or 70% (General Systems)</b> Applicants will be admitted as an Engineering Qualifying student if they are missing one subject that is used for Final Admission, but have still have an average of 70% on the remaining four courses. <b>Kinesiology &amp; Health Studies - 70%</b> Bachelor of Kinesiology (all majors) requires Math 30-1 and one of Biology 30, Chemistry 30, or Physics 30. Applicants will be admitted as a Kinesiology Qualifying student if: (a) missing one of the subjects used for Final Admission, and/or (b) have an admission average that is between 65-69.99%.	English Language Arts 30-1 Math 30-1 or Math 30-2 One Course from Category A or B One Course from Category A or B One Course from Category A, B, or C
<b>Nursing - 70% (in each course)</b> Nursing is a competitive entry program.	English Language Arts 30-1 Math 30-1 or Math 30-2 or Math 31 Chemistry 30 Biology 30 One Course from Category A or B
<b>Science - 70%</b> Applicants will be admitted as a Science Qualifying student if they are either: (a) missing one of the subjects used for Final Admission, but have an admission average of 70% on the remaining four courses, or (b) have an admission average between 65-69.99%, but have all of the five subjects required. ## NOTES

- A maximum of two different Math courses can be used in the Admission Calculation.
- French Immersion students may use the equivalent French courses.
- Français 30 may be used in place of English Language Arts 30-1.
- Any 30-level language course not listed may also be used as a Category B course.
- Courses identified above should be 5-credits each. Two 3-credit courses\* may be used in place of one 5-credit course requirement.
- Applicants to joint programs must meet the requirements of both programs.
