Number of scholarships awarded	Over \$3M a year in scholarships for first year students. All automatic assessed entrance awards are renewable.

	Larger awards include our Leadership Award, which is a free residence room for a year, and our Presidents Scholarship which is a blank cheque, full ride scholarship
Scholarship application deadline	March 1st
Decision criteria	Basic entrance awards: accepted by march 1 st with a minimum 80% average (three academic 12 courses must be available for assessment by March 1 st) For applied for larger scholarships: accepted by march 1 st with a minimum 80% average. Additional documents such as resumes, references, essays, and interviews may be required
Guaranteed scholarship program	Guaranteed with an 80% average or higher

Treatment of diploma marks	Provincial final mark with a combination of school and diploma exam
Transcript requirements	We require official transcripts for assessment on initial application, updated marks for scholarships, and final transcripts upon graduation
Tuition differentials	Tuition for out of province students: \$9,106 - \$9,558 Undergraduate courses (non lab) = \$910.60 Undergraduate courses with a lab = \$946.99 Undergraduate science courses = \$955.79
Treatment of second choice program(s)	Students must contact admissions to be considered for a second choice program. Assessment initially occurs for primary program. If a student does not meet admission requirements of a program, but are generally admissible, they will be offered General Arts admission

NEW INSTITUTION UPDATES/HIGHLIGHTS

- MSVU is launching is Doctoral program in Clinical Psychology in September 2026. This will be accompanied by fully subsidized research and teaching clinical psychology lab for youth mental health in Halifax
- MSVU launches 14 month Bachelors of Education program which began intake in May 2025. This program will allow students to complete their teaching credentials in an expedited manner, and begin teaching in classrooms faster
- MSVU introduces revamped programs in Family Science and Aging. Originally called Family Studies and Gerontology, the new programs introduce two new majors in the field, directed research opportunities, and pathways to our graduate programs
