Conditional admissions process	We can assess for conditional offers as early as November based on first semester's midterm grades and grade 11 grades. Any grade 11 grade will be replaced by the completion of grade 12 credits.
IB credit information	Applicants who have successfully completed the IB diploma with at least six subjects, including three at the higher level (HL), with a minimum final score of 24 (not including bonus points), will be considered for admission. Program specific prerequisites may apply. Timing of offers/grades used	Nipissing University assesses applications on a rolling basis and provides admission decisions between November - May. Students may hear back during that time period, however, students applying to Nursing, Physical and Health Education, or Orientation to the Master of Arts in History typically hear back in mid-May.
Deferral policy	Applicants admitted to an undergraduate degree or post-baccalaureate diploma program who are unable to begin their studies for the term admitted to may submit a request for a deferral.
