A student's final grades for all coursework completed prior to June 30th of Grade 12 year will be used to confirm their offer of admission.</p>

- Mathematics 20-1 or Mathematics 20-2
- One of Science 20, Biology 20, Chemistry 20 or Physics 20

Grade 12

- English Language Arts 30-1 (min 70%)
- Mathematics 30-1 (min 75%)
- Physics 30 (min 75%)
- Chemistry 30 (min 75%)
- Mathematics 31 *Recommended (for Spring 2024 admission onwards)*
