Policy on summer school, night school, online courses, and correspondence courses	<p>Summer school courses taken over the summer after grade 12 cannot be considered for admission purposes. Summer school courses taken before grade 12 will be considered in the admission process.</p> <p>Online courses must be 100% complete by June 30th to be considered in the admission process. If an online course does not appear on the interim transcript, the student should reach out to the UBC Admissions team to let us know they are taking the course (recruitment.ok@ubc.ca)</p>
Treatment of out-of-province high school courses from schools such as Blyth or MEI	Courses taken outside of Alberta will be considered on a case-by-case basis and may impact the competitive nature of an application.
