ADMISSIONS INFORMATION

Minimum Alberta admission requirements	St. John's, Grenfell and Labrador campuses: To be eligible for general undergraduate admission, applicants need to successfully complete Grade 12 with a 70% average in senior level high school courses in five subject areas: English, mathematics*, laboratory science*, social studies or modern/classical language*, elective. *Students who are missing an eligible course in one of these subject groups, who apply for admission to a program that does not require completion of these courses, will be considered for general admission. In this case, an eligible course in another subject group (excluding elective) above may be used to substitute the missing course.
	Marine Institute: To be eligible for general admission, applicants shall

	have completed graduation requirements for high school with a minimum combined average of 60% in Grade 12 mathematics, English and laboratory science. Students completing academic level math require a minimum overall average of 60% in that course.

Policy on repeated courses	St. John's, Grenfell and Labrador campuses: If a course is repeated, the higher of the two marks is used to calculate the admissions average. Marine Institute: Students are permitted a maximum of 3 attempts at each course for which a grade is awarded.
Policy on summer school, night school, online courses, and correspondence courses	St. John's, Grenfell and Labrador campuses: We will accept courses taken outside the standard high school setting as long as the courses follow the curriculum set by the AB Ministry of Education or another recognized curriculum. Marine Institute: All programs/courses would be reviewed by our Admissions Office once an applicant has submitted an application.

Application deadline	St. John's, Grenfell and Labrador campuses: Application deadlines vary by program. Marine Institute: Applications should be received by April 15 (March 1 for international students). Applications received following these dates will be assessed as resources and space allow.
Application fee	St. John's, Grenfell and Labrador campuses: General application fee is \$70 for Canadian citizens and permanent residents, and \$300 for international students. Marine Institute: Application fee is \$60 for Canadian citizens and permanent residents and \$120 for international applicants.
Timing of offers/grades used	St. John's, Grenfell and Labrador campuses: Processing times Grades used Marine Institute: Offers will begin in October; we will use grade 11 marks along with confirmation of enrolled grade 12 courses (confirm they are taking required grade 12 courses for admission).
Deferral policy	St. John's, Grenfell and Labrador campuses Marine Institute: We allow for one deferral; after that applicants have to re-apply.
